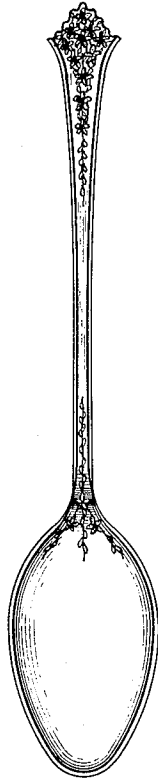

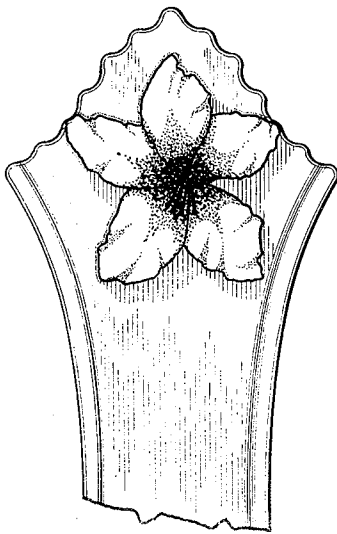
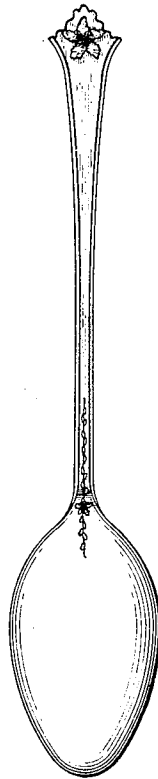

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, George Honnet, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at Wilmington, in the county of New Hanover and State of North Carolina, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Spoon or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof, wherein:

Fig. 1 is a front elevational view of a spoon, showing my new design;

Fig. 2, a rear elevation; and

Fig. 3 is an enlarged fragmentary rear elevation.
