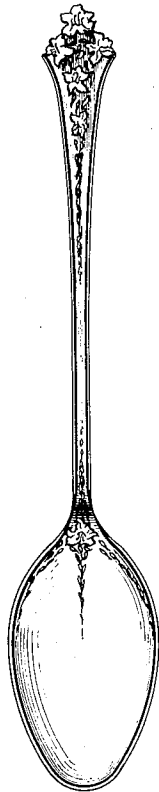

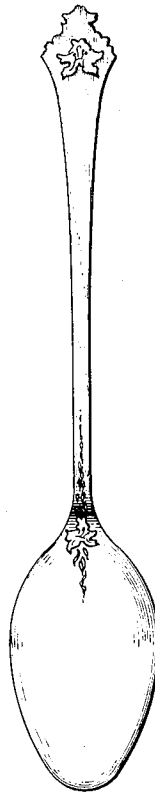

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, George Honnet, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at Wilmington, in the county of New Hanover and State of North Carolina, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Spoon or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof, wherein:

Fig. 1 is a front elevation of a spoon, showing my new design;

Fig. 2, a rear elevation thereof;

Fig. 3, a fragmentary front elevation of the upper portion of the spoon handle on a somewhat enlarged scale; and,

Fig. 4, a fragmentary rear elevation of the

upper portion of the spoon handle also on an enlarged scale.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a spoon or similar article, as shown and described.
