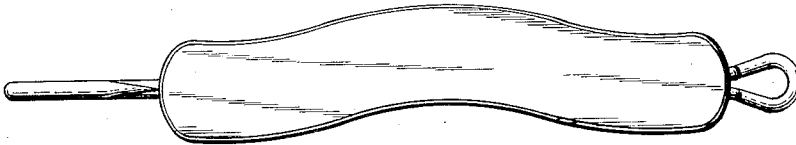

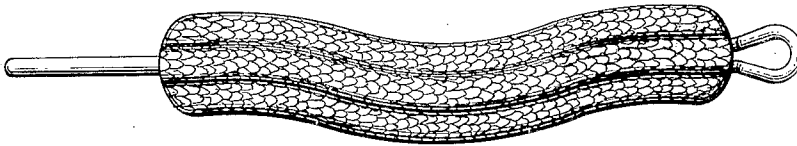

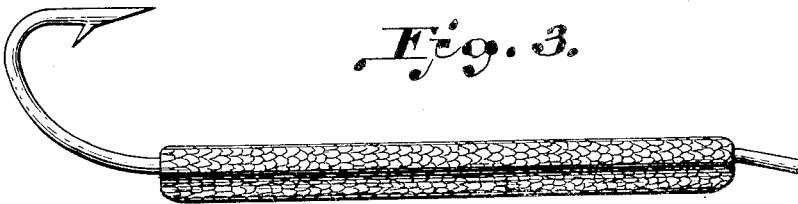
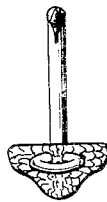

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Louis Bryant Finberg, a citizen of the United States, residing at Wilmington, in the county of New Hanover and State of North Carolina, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design of a Trolling Fish Lure, of which the following is a specification, reference being had therein to the accompanying drawing forming part thereof, in which

Figure 1 is an enlarged top plan view of a trolling fish lure, showing my new design.

Figure 2 is an enlarged bottom plan view.

Figure 3 is an enlarged view in side elevation.

Figure 4 is an enlarged end view in elevation.
